- **Historical Origins:** The pre-tribulation rapture doctrine gained prominence in the 19th century, notably through figures like John Nelson Darby and the subsequent publication of the Scofield Reference Bible. Some researchers suggest that external influences, including Freemasonry, may have played a role in promoting dispensationalist theology to steer Christian
